Khafre K. Abif will travel the 2,028 mile corridor of the Underground Railroad Bicycle Route to bring awareness to the HIV/AIDS Epidemic in African American Communities. Black Americans account for more HIV/AIDS cases, people estimated to be living with HIV/AIDS, and HIV related deaths than any other racial/ethnic group in the US. Abif hopes to bring awareness to the high numbers by biking the 2,028 mile journey beginning in Mobile, Alabama, traveling as far north as Canada and ending in Owen Sound—a town founded by freedom seekers and located on the southern side of Lake Huron's Georgian Bay. The journey will begin on Sunday, June 27, 2010 and takes 65 days. The symbolism of the journey is unique in that the route honors the bravery of those who fled the bondage of slavery and those that provided shelter. Abif honors the bravery of the thousands of Black Americans living with HIV/AIDS
